### 2007 Westerly Vineyards sauvignon blanc

**VARIETAL(S):** 100% Sauvignon Blanc

**APPELLATION:** 100% Santa Ynez Valley

**VINEYARD(S):** McGinley Vineyard, Star Lane Vineyard

**BRIX AT HARVEST:** ~ 23.6°

**PH:** 3.33

**TA:** 6.33 g/L

**ALCOHOL:** 14.3% by volume

**COOPERAGE:** 65% neutral oak barrels / 35% stainless steel tanks  
(no new oak) – on the lees for 6 months

**FERMENTATION:** whole-cluster pressed, cold settled, barrel fermented in neutral oak and stainless steel barrels with VL3 yeast. No malo-lactic fermentation.

**PRODUCTION:** 2,200 cases

**RECOMMENDED RETAIL:** \$19.99/bottle

**NOTES:** Grass and key lime on the nose, with some tropical fruit and grapefruit notes as well. Rich but lively on the palate, with citrus as well as tropical fruit and some melon flavors. Bright acidity leads to a long, clean finish. Reminiscent, in some aspects, of both New Zealand sauvignon blanc and Loire Valley Sancerre.
